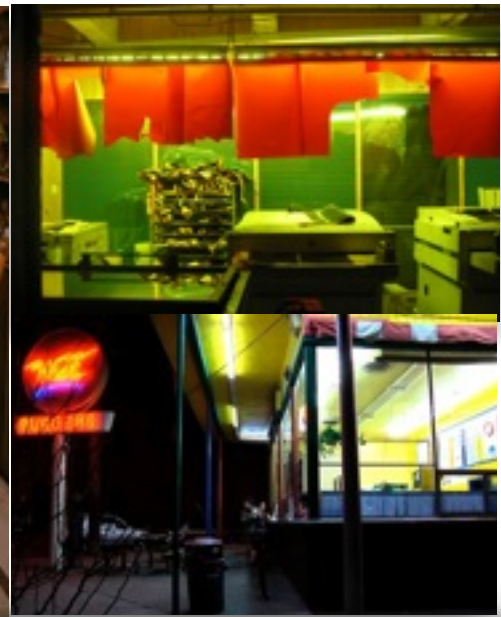

She has exhibited at the Museum of Chinese in American in New York, NY, the Bronx Museum of the Arts, Cornell University, the Palm Springs Art Museum, Capricious, the Philadelphia Photo Art Center, Gallery 339 in Philadelphia, and the Eighth Veil in Los Angeles. She was a SPARC Artist-in Residence through the New York City Department of Cultural Affairs, and completed the Artist in the Marketplace Program throughout the Bronx Museum of Arts. She is the recipient of the 2014-2015 Robert Giard Fellowship. She currently teaches at Yale University, where she was appointed lecturer in 2013, as well as Parsons the New School of Design.
