The Student Finance Office (SFO) is now accepting online application for **Financial Assistance Scheme for Post-secondary Students (FASP)** and **Non-means-tested Loan Scheme for Post-secondary Students (NLSPS)** for AY2021/22. Students who need government financial assistance, including successful applicants of the current academic year, should apply by **3 June 2022**, and all required supporting documents by **10 June 2022**.

AY2021/22 Student Locker Clearance (Deadline – 30 June 2022)

According to the "[Regulations for the usage of student locker](#)", student who have applied for a student locker on Tsing Yi or Chai Wan campus should note that the deadline of student locker clearance is **30 June 2022**, after which routine clearance and annual maintenance of lockers would be conducted.
