

**Points to Note for Enrollment of Module**  
**GEE5314 Health and Medical Technology Development in**  
**Guangdong-**  
**Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area**

1. The module curriculum covers lectures, seminars, field study and guided site visits. Both Cantonese and Putonghua are used as the medium of instruction in the course.
2. Students are required to join a 5-day trip (**17 – 21 June 2024**) in the Greater Bay Area of China which is a compulsory part of the module, a tentative itinerary is given in **Annex A**. In this regard, students should hold valid travel documents to Mainland China including but not limited to Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card, Home Visit Permit 港澳居民來往內地通行證 (回鄉證) or passport either.
3. Students shall pay a tour fee of **around HK\$5,000** for a basic 5-day trip after successful registration of the module. Round-trip transportation, basic meals and accommodation will be included in the paid study tour. The VTC will provide the coverage of travelling insurance for each student who enrolled this module.
4. Students shall receive a final result of the module GEE5314 on **23 August 2024** and “I” (Incomplete) as the result of the module will be shown in the report of Semester 2, AY2023/24.
5. Students may apply for the sponsorship from China Candlelight Fund, if eligible, details are given in **Annex B** and promotion poster is given in **Annex C**.
6. Funding applications should be submitted to The Department of Food and Health Sciences for further follow up.

## **Sponsorship Scheme under the China Candlelight Educational Fund**

**Funding mode:** On student-based

**Target of Beneficiaries:** Financial Needy Students of any full-time programmes in VTC and its member institutions

**Requirement of Beneficiary Students:** To qualify for the sponsorship, a student must:

- a) demonstrate with financially disadvantage. For example, in receipt of financial assistance from the HKSARG Student Finance Office, any VTC's student financial assistance scheme or Comprehensive Social Security Assistance from the Social Welfare Department;
- b) enrol in an outbound programme/activity to be held in the Greater China Region organised by VTC or its member institutions; and
- c) be a full-time student of VTC throughout the outbound programme/activity.

**Sponsorship Amount:** The approved sponsorship amount, which is 75% of the trip cost with a maximum sponsorship capped at \$10,000 for each student at each study level.

# China Candlelight Educational Fund Sponsorship for Student Outbound Programme/Activity in Mainland China or Greater China Region

## Eligibility

Applicant must:

- enrol in an outbound programme/activity held in Mainland China or the Greater China Region organised by VTC or its member institutions; *AND*
- be a registered student of a full-time programme in VTC or its member institutions at the time of application and throughout the outbound programme/activity mentioned above; *AND*
- in receipt of ANY financial assistance from the HKSARG Student Finance Office and/or other VTC's student financial assistance scheme(s) for his/her study at VTC; OR whose family is a recipient of the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance from Social Welfare Department.

## Application

The student in need should approach the organising unit of the respective outbound programme/activity and submit the necessary documentary proof, as soon as practicable.
